Aim is to link WP1, 2, 3, & 4 with each of the case studies (grouped in 4 clusters due to time constraints) The allocation of the case studies to one of the 4 clusters will be determined in conjunction with case study leaders.

The round-robin session require the case study clusters to sit in one of 4 rooms and the WP1, 2, 3, & 4 representatives rotate around the rooms. This session build from the documents describing their case studies which will be completed prior to the meeting. These sessions are designed (90 min) to allow sufficient time for each case study representative to present their study site to each of the other case studies in their cluster and WP representatives by systematically consider their site from the perspective of WP1, 2, 3 & 4 in each of the separate round robin sessions – suggested time 30 min (5-10 min per case study site). The WP representatives will then suggest potential tools/methodologies etc specific to that group of case studies (20 min) and co-design work-plan for the coming 12 months with each case study representative within the cluster (20 min) which will be documented and criteria on which to judge their usefulness determined towards the end of the session (20 min). These sessions will focus on the exact methods and synergies between case studies within clusters. A draft work plan will be produced for each case study at the end of each session which collectively will form the full plan for each case study and each WP for the following 12 months.
